- -A student applicant must be in good standing (a minimum of a 2.5 GPA) at an accredited university or technical institute, and in an academic program leading to an undergraduate or graduate degree.
- -A postgraduate applicant must also be in good standing and have received a college degree (bachelor's or master's degree) within five years of the fellow's start date.
- 2. SEAP/CQL (OPEN TO UNDERGRADS and HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS) APPLICATION DEADLINE: 1 MARCH 2019 U.S. Army Research Laboratory (ARL) College Qualified Leaders (CQL) and the Science and Engineer Apprentice Program (SEAP) appointment dates are May to August 2019. The deadline to submit applications is 1 March 2019.

- -CQL applicants are undergraduates only and must be currently enrolled in a STEM major. Students are limited to 1040 hours in the lab in a 12 month period and must be a U.S. Citizen Permanent Resident
- 3. U.S. Army Research Laboratory (ARL) University Career Experience program (UCEP) appointment dates are flexible (Any 10 week period May to August 2019). The deadline to submit applications is 1 March 2019. Student stipend is supported by the Outreach Office.
- -UCEP applicants are ARL Partner Institution College Students or Recently Graduated B.S. Students and must be currently enrolled in a STEM major. Students must be a U.S. Citizen Permanent Resident.
